WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's Disabled Parking Enforcement Team (DPET) consists of 30 volunteers, many of whom are disabled, who ensure that parking access for all disabled persons, their vehicles and special equipment (wheelchairs) is available; and

WHEREAS, DPET volunteers actively participate in education efforts directed toward the public and businesses in order to improve and maintain such parking access for disabled citizens; and

WHEREAS, volunteers with the unit perform patrols and private property inspections to ensure compliance with current parking standards and make appropriate referrals when such standards are not met; and

WHEREAS, DPET volunteers enforce current parking laws when violations occur or when educational attempts have failed, in order to restore parking access to disabled persons; and

WHEREAS, the Disabled Parking Enforcement Team acts as a liaison between the disabled community and The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby recognizes the importance of the Disabled Parking Enforcement Team Volunteers and commends them for their accomplishments and involvement in the community and The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that June 2, 1997 is hereby proclaimed to be  
"DISABLED PARKING ENFORCEMENT TEAM VOLUNTEERS DAY" in San Diego.
