

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288755

ADOPTED ON JUN 09 1997

WHEREAS, the Science Classes of Diegueno Junior High School have consistently contributed to the protection and restoration of the natural resources within the San Dieguito River Valley; and

WHEREAS, this is the third year that the students have generously donated the proceeds from their pancake breakfast to the San Dieguito River Park to be used exclusively for habitat acquisition and wetland restoration projects, including the 105-Acre Coastal Project and the Partners for Wildlife-San Pasqual Project; and

WHEREAS, the students have determined that this year's donation shall be used to assist the River Park in acquiring a 105-acre parcel within the western river that once acquired will be set aside in permanent open space and included within the proposed San Dieguito Lagoon Restoration project boundaries; and

WHEREAS, their efforts to preserve, protect and restore wetlands within the San Dieguito River Valley are inspirational and worthy of recognition; and

WHEREAS, the students' generous donations of \$4,000 this year and an additional \$12,100 over the past two years represent a significant contribution to the Park's effort to restore and protect wetlands throughout the length of the San Dieguito River Valley; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby thank the students, faculty, and parents of

Diegueno Junior High School for their commitment to the restoration and preservation of San Diego's precious natural resources, and for the example that they have set for all the residents of the region.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Monday, June 9, 1997 be and is hereby proclaimed to be **"DIEGUENO JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL'S SCIENCE CLASSES DAY"** in The City of San Diego.
