RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288860

ADOPTED ON JUN 30 1997

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept and expend a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), in cooperation with the California Department of Health and Human Service (DHHS) and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), titled "San Diego Safe Communities," the purpose of which is to develop and implement a comprehensive coalition, needs and resource assessment, and strategic plan for the prevention of fatal and injury accidents related to traffic, industrial, home, school, and other causes, as described in the grant application proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 288860;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, by and through the Chief of Police, to execute said grant agreement, and that this authority shall include all aspects of program operation and expenditures, under the terms and conditions of the approved grant program proposal, including any amendments or extensions thereof, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said grant;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authority shall extend to future grant renewals, extensions and/or additional funds for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and/or the California Office of Traffic Safety and/or the California Department of Health and Human Services for essentially

the same purposes and activities as the Safe Communities grant program, and provided commitments of City with respect to this program remain essentially unchanged;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel and contractual positions funded by this grant award are not subject to local hiring freezes.
