WHEREAS, the Renaissance Commission was established to conduct a reconnaissance mission to identify how to maintain and improve the City's neighborhoods; and


WHEREAS, on February 12, 1997, the Committee on Public Safety and Neighborhood Services recommended establishment of a Livable Neighborhood/ Economic Need Fund and an Older Community Fund to serve as the Neighborhood Revitalization Superfund for Fiscal Year 1997; and

WHEREAS, \$67,952 in Gas Tax funding (302191) and \$1,672,048 in the Renaissance Commission Transnet funding (30300) has been identified to fund the Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund (30304); and

WHEREAS, \$443,000 in the Renaissance Commission Transnet funding (30300) has been identified to fund the Older Community Fund (30305) (40 Years or Older); NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate and expend the Fiscal Year 1997 Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund and the Older Community Fund (40 Years or Older) as directed by the Council Districts.
