## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288936 ADOPTED ON JUL 14 1997

WHEREAS, as a companion to this Resolution, Resolution Number R- 288935

(R-97-1481) authorizes the sale of the last remaining City-owned vacant lot, Lot 3, in the South San Diego Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service (USPS) desires to purchase the lot at fair market value to develop the property for the Otay Mesa Carrier Annex that is intended to be operated by the Postal Service for a minimum of 50 years; and

WHEREAS, when the SSDIP was formed in 1978, a Declaration of Restrictions was placed on the property which governs the development criteria for all of the lots in the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, as a federal agency, the USPS has specific construction and security requirements which conflict with provisions contained in the Declaration of Restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the USPS has requested the City to waive these restrictions, on this lot only, so it can acquire this parcel and build its facility; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in the Declaration of Restrictions, City has requested and received the consent from the existing SSDIP property owners to remove the restrictions on Lot 3; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that all restrictions

contained in the Declaration of Restrictions be and is hereby removed from Lot 3, SSDIP, Unit

#1.
