WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public street easements by City Council resolution where for a period of five consecutive years the street or highway has been impassable for vehicular travel and no money was expended for maintenance on the street or highway during such period; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owner has requested the vacation of the City's interest in an unneeded street reservation within Lot A of Map 6571 and Parcel A of Map 7400, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18440-1-B, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has made an irrevocable offer to dedicate an 8.5 foot easement for pedestrian and non-motorized purposes as indicated on Drawing No. 18440-2-B; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the street easement either for the public street system, for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes;
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land;
 - (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community;

Plan; and

(d) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will

not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the street reservation in Lot A of Map 6571 and in Parcel A of Map 7400, as more

particularly shown on Drawing No. 18440-1-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as

Document No. RR- 289178 , which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a

part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

2. That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City

Council an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication of a 8.5 foot-wide easement for pedestrian and non-

motor vehicle access purposes and presently rejects the dedication, but reserves the right to

dedicate any portion of such area at any time in the future and will put the dedication before the

City Council at that time.

3. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him

under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


