A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CALLING FOR THE FORMATION OF A PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR THE PROPOSED NORTH BAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND ADOPTING A PROCEDURE FOR THE FORMATION OF THE PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") by Resolutions

No. R-287333, adopted on May 14, 1996, and R-289083, adopted August 11, 1997, approved a redevelopment survey area to study and determine the feasibility of a redevelopment project or projects therein; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is preparing a redevelopment plan for the proposed North Bay Redevelopment Project in accordance with the California Community Redevelopment Law, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to subdivision (a) of Section 33385 of the Community

Redevelopment Law, the Council shall call upon the residents, businesses and existing community

organizations in the project area to form a project area committee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 33385 of the Community

Redevelopment Law, the Council shall, by resolution, adopt a procedure for the formation of the project area committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council has published and mailed notice of a Council meeting this date to consider adoption of a proposed "Procedure for Formation of Project Area Committee for the

North Bay Redevelopment Project" relative to the formation and selection of the Project Area Committee; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council hereby calls upon the residents, business owners, and existing community organizations in the North Bay Redevelopment Project area to form a project area committee in accordance with the California Community Redevelopment Law.
