

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-289306

ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 21, 1997


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Juvenile Realignment Task Force be and hereby is authorized and directed to continue to develop a comprehensive, multi-agency plan that identifies the resources and strategies for providing an effective continuum of responses for the prevention, intervention, supervision, treatment and, if required, incarceration of juvenile offenders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Diego Police Department is authorized and directed to work with the City's grants coordinator to seek funding opportunities to support the Council priority for early intervention in juvenile crime prevention.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that youth and family development is a top priority for the City's Social Services Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") allocations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the City's desire that applications for such CDBG funds stress the collaborative nature of the applicant's programs with other social service providers to attain measurable results in diverting youth from crime and creating strong, stable families.
