A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO GRANTING CONSENT TO THE CASA DE LA PLAYA GEOLOGIC HAZARD ABATEMENT DISTRICT TO THE FORMATION OF A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT TO FINANCE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEAWALL..

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Casa De La Playa Geologic Hazard Abatement District (the "GHAD"), wholly located within the City of San Diego, has proposed the adoption of a Resolution of Intention for the installation of certain public works of improvement consisting of a seawall, together with appurtenances and appurtenant work in what is know and designated as ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 97-1 (Seawall Project) (hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"), under the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and.

WHEREAS, such Board of Directors has requested the consent of the City Council to the adoption of the proposed Resolution of Intention and to the granting of consent to allow the project to proceed; and

WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code section 10104 requires that the City Council grant consent to the proceedings of the GHAD and the proposed Resolution of Intention prior to the time that the Resolution of Intention for the proceedings of the GHAD may be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.


2. That the public convenience and necessity require the improvements as referred to in the proposed Resolution of Intention for the works of improvement, together with appurtenances, in the proposed Assessment District.

3. That the City Council hereby grants its consent to the following:

- a. The formation of the Assessment District;
- b. The assumption of jurisdiction by the GHAD for all purposes in connection with the Assessment District;
- c. The consent to the proposed Resolution of Intention; and
- d. The consent to and approval of the boundaries of the proposed Assessment District.

4. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the GHAD.
