WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) desires to apply for and, if selected, to accept and expend a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) called "Safe Communities-2000," the purpose of which is to expand the scope of the City's Buckle Up San Diego (BUSD) program to include general traffic, pedestrian and bicycle safety, as described in the grant application proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-289369; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manger be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to accept and administer funds for the Safe Communities-2000 program, and that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant acceptance, operation, expenditures, and certification that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding for this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the California Office of Traffic Safety;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Safe Communities-2000 proposal was developed by the current BUSD staff, and that it is the intent of OTS that BUSD staff operate the Safe Communities-2000 program; after OTS approval of the proposal, SDPD staff will separately process documentation and recommendation for sole-source selection, along with Subcontract Agreements for these individuals;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the City of San Diego. The State of California and the California Office of Traffic Safety disclaim responsibility for any such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded hereunder are not subject to local hiring freezes.
