

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-289388

ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 4, 1997

RESOLUTION CONSIDERING THE PROTESTS IN THE
MATTER OF THE SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD LANDSCAPE
MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1.

WHEREAS, the notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of protests in the matter of the San Ysidro Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District No. 1 (the "District"), under Resolution of Intention No. R-289116, adopted on September 8, 1997, having been duly given in the manner required by law and the legal time for filing such protests and the time fixed for hearing thereon having passed; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the public hearing for the proposed assessments for the District, the majority of the assessment ballots submitted to the City were opposed to the levy of the proposed assessments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Council confirms that a majority protest exists in accordance with Article XIII D, Section 4 of the California Constitution and Section 53753(c) of the California Government Code.
2. That the assessments described in Document No. RR-289117, on file in the office of the City Clerk and on file in the office of the Street Superintendent, shall not be levied.

3. That the maintenance described in said Resolution of Intention shall not be performed and no City funds, other than those generally authorized for maintenance, shall be authorized or used to perform the maintenance.
