

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 289417

ADOPTED ON NOV 18 1997

WHEREAS, the "Meyers-Milias-Brown Act," contained in California Government Code sections 3500, et seq., provides for the orderly administration of employer-employee relations; and

WHEREAS, contained in said sections are provisions for the adoption by a public agency of reasonable rules and regulations for recognizing employee organizations and meeting and conferring with such recognized employee organizations regarding matters that directly affect and primarily involve wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act and the Charter of The City of San Diego, the City Council has enacted Council Policy 300-6 to provide for the government of employer-employee relations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act, the public agency, herein The City of San Diego, by and through the City Council, is authorized to designate a Management Team as its representative to accomplish the meet and confer process on its behalf; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary and appropriate to designate said Management Team for The City of San Diego for such meet and confer purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that pursuant to appropriate and applicable provisions of law and Council Policy, the following persons be and they are hereby appointed and designated as the Management Team for purposes of meeting and conferring with recognized employee organizations:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Personnel Director and the Retirement Administrator be and they are hereby appointed to and designated as members of the Management Team, pursuant to the above-cited provisions of law and Council Policy, for all purposes except meeting and conferring with employee organizations.
