WHEREAS, the State of California has passed Senate Bill 11 appropriating funding for the Fiscal Year 1997/1998 "Citizens' Option for Public Safety," which was authorized in 1996 by Assembly Bill (AB) 3229, and the purpose of which is to supplement the front line law enforcement resources of local jurisdictions throughout the State; and


WHEREAS, funding allocated to the San Diego Police Department is two million, seven hundred fifty three thousand, three hundred and nineteen dollars (\$2,753,319.00); and

WHEREAS, AB 3229 requires that the City Council appropriate these funds in accordance with the request of the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the approximate allocation of the funds will be: Central Division Station (\$1,500,000.00); police vehicles (\$924,700.00); and miscellaneous equipment including Crime Lab Genetic Analyzer, telephones, portable radios, and various other equipment and communication upgrades (\$328,700.00); and

WHEREAS, AB 3229 requires that the City set up a Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund to receive and expend these funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City Manager, be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept and expend these Citizens' Options for Public Safety Grant funds from the State of California;



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to set up a Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund, as required by the legislation, to receive and expend these funds;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all aspects of program operation including any amendments and extensions, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
