## Council Policy Number 600-14 Amendment

The paragraph under the heading "BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD" is to be amended as follows:

The area of applicability of this policy is that identified as areas of special flood hazard in a report entitled "Flood Insurance Study, City of San Diego, California" dated April 18, 1983 June 19, 1997, published by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Mapsidated June 19, 1997, and all subsequent amendments and/of revisions. This Flood Insurance Study and attendant mapping is the minimum area of applicability of this policy, and may be supplemented by studies for other areas which are recommended to the City of San Diego by FEMA or the Federal Insurance Administration. No structure or land development shall be constructed, located, extended, converted or altered without full compliance with the terms of this policy and other applicable regulations.
