A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DESIGNATING THE MID-CITY PARKING METER DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD AS THE ADVISORY BOARD FOR PARKING METER DISTRICT 3; AUTHORIZING CONTINUED MID-CITY PARKING METER DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD INVOLVEMENT IN IMPLEMENTATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE MID-CITY PARKING PLAN, ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE MID-CITY PARKING PLAN, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$122,166 TO IMPLEMENT SHORT-TERM IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") by Resolution

No. R-288408 adopted on March 4, 1997, adopted Council Policy 100-18 entitled the "Parking

Meter Revenue Allocation and Expenditure Policy"; and

WHEREAS, a percentage of the total parking meter revenues generated by The City of San Diego shall be allocated to Parking Meter Districts to address parking and parking-related improvements; and

WHEREAS, "Parking Meter District 3" established by the Council includes the Mid-City Community Plan Area and the Golden Hill Community Plan Area, the El Cajon Business Improvement Districts, the Adams Avenue Business Improvement District, the North Park Business Improvement District, and the City Heights Business Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-City Parking Meter District Advisory Board is acting on behalf of the Council to implement planning and administration of parking-related activities within the Mid-City Community Plan Area and the Golden Hill Community Plan Area, the Hillcrest Business

Improvement District, the El Cajon Business Improvement Districts, the Adams Avenue Business Improvement District, the North Park Business Improvement District, and the City Heights Business Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, a Parking Meter District Advisory Board shall be designated by the Council to recommend programs and expenditures of parking meter revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-City Parking Meter District Advisory Board has prepared the "Comprehensive Mid-City Parking Plan" with extensive community input to identify necessary parking and parking-related improvements throughout the planning area; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Mid-City Parking Meter District Advisory Board is designated as the Parking Meter District Advisory Board of Parking Meter District 3.
- 2. That the Mid-City Parking Meter District Advisory Board involvement is continued in the implementation of the "Comprehensive Mid-City Parking Plan" and the development of future parking plan recommendations as long as the Mid-City Parking Meter District is in existence.
- 4. That the City Council shall review the status of the above-mentioned Parking

 District on an annual basis to determine what monies have been allocated and which have been
 spent. Specific projects may come before the City Council for review as they move through the
 City's approval process. In the event that a proposed project calls for the construction of a

parking structure or the acquisition of a parking structure, the City Council may elect at that time to extend the term of the Parking District, pursuant to the law in existence at that time, for the purpose of providing for long-term financing.

- 5. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$122,166 to implement the "Short-Term Improvements" included in the "Comprehensive Mid-City Parking Plan" is authorized.
- That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$5,904 to reimburse the General Fund's cost to administer this district is authorized.
