

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 289523

ADOPTED ON DEC 09 1997

WHEREAS, St. Augustine High School is a Catholic, college preparatory high school for young men grades 9 through 12 located in the North Park community of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, St. Augustine was founded in September of 1922 by Father Alphonse Martel and is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges; and

WHEREAS, St. Augustine currently enrolls 600 students from communities throughout San Diego County and Tijuana, Mexico as well as over 6,500 alumni with approximately 3,000 living and working in San Diego County as successful members of the professional and business community; and

WHEREAS, St. Augustine has 40 experienced faculty members, 22 with Master's degrees, and 2 with Doctorates and offers a curriculum that includes college preparatory courses, advanced placement and honors courses in addition to the more traditional courses in music, art, drama, chemistry, physics, computer sciences and physical education; and

WHEREAS, St. Augustine is celebrating the 75th Anniversary of the school's founding;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby recognize the outstanding contributions that ST. AUGUSTINE HIGH SCHOOL has made towards meeting the range of education opportunities for the citizens of The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that December 8, 1997, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "St. Augustine High School Day" in The City of San Diego.
