WHEREAS, the Foreign Trade Zones Board of the United States Department of Commerce has authorized The City of San Diego, California, to establish and operate Foreign-Trade Zone No. 153 and such alternate sites and special purpose subzones as are necessary to serve commerce and industry in the San Diego area; and


WHEREAS, Hewlett-Packard Company ("Hewlett-Packard") is a valued high technology industrial concern in the San Diego area; and

WHEREAS, Hewlett-Packard has need of a special purpose subzone for its continued operations in the City of San Diego and has requested the City to apply to the Foreign-Trade Zones Board for authority to establish a subzone of Foreign Trade Zone No. 153 for use by Hewlett-Packard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is authorized to file documents requesting the Foreign-Trade Zones Board, International Trade Administration, United States Department of Commerce, to execute the application for a special purpose subzone in accordance with regulations pursuant to federal law (15 C.F.R. Part 400) for

the use and benefit of Hewlett-Packard and further the City Manager is authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to complete the authorization process.
