ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 16, 1997

WHEREAS, the United States Navy instituted a program for the deposit of sand, dredged from the San Diego harbor, onto or near local beaches for replenishment and erosion control purposes; and


WHEREAS, that program has been stopped, because of ordnance found in the dredged sand, and the Navy has proceeded to dump the sand in the deep ocean off the California coast; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to discuss with the Navy alternative solutions to safely proceed with the deposit of sand on local beaches; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager and the City Attorney be and they are hereby directed to write a letter in support of the Attorney General's action requesting a temporary restraining order against the U.S. Navy's dumping of sand dredged from San Diego harbor into the deep ocean.
