

ORDINANCE NUMBER **O 18509** (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON **MAY 04 1998**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6, BY ADDING DIVISION 13, SECTIONS 26.1301, 26.1302 AND 26.1303 CREATING QUALCOMM STADIUM ADVISORY BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Chapter II, Article 6, by adding Division 13, sections 26.1301, 26.1302 and 26.1303, to read as follows:

**DIVISION 13**

**QUALCOMM STADIUM ADVISORY BOARD**

**SEC. 26.1301 PURPOSE AND INTENT**

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Qualcomm Stadium Advisory Board pursuant to Section 43(a) of the City Charter to serve as an advisory body to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager on matters relating to the operations of Qualcomm Stadium.

**SEC. 26.1302 QUALCOMM STADIUM ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED**

There is hereby created a Qualcomm Stadium Advisory Board consisting of nine (9) members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be

appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

The members shall serve four (4) year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. Of the initial nine (9) members appointed, five (5) shall serve a term of four (4) years and four (4) shall serve a term of two (2) years. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for a term of office of four (4) years. The expiration date of all terms shall be January 1. During January of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall on or after February 15 select a Chairperson from among its members.

All members of the board shall be residents of the County of San Diego and no fewer than seven (7) shall be residents of The City of San Diego.

A conflict of interest code shall be adopted for this Board. All members shall be required to complete and file a Statement of Economic Interests. Failure to file a Statement of Economic Interests will be considered cause for removal.

The Board shall adopt rules consistent with the law for the government of its business and procedures.

#### **SEC. 26.1303 DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS**

The Board shall:

(a) Conduct public meetings to provide a forum on Qualcomm Stadium operations and receive public input on Stadium issues.

(b) Serve as liaison between the public, Qualcomm Stadium tenants, contractors, and the City.


(c) Provide recommendations to the Mayor and City Council on any action that requires City Council approval.

(d) Not have any financial or budgetary authority.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
