AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-18424 (NEW SERIES), TITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1997-98" BY CONTINUING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BUDGET FOR THE CONVENTION CENTER EXPANSION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-18424, titled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1997-98 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," was duly adopted by the City Council on July 29, 1997 (the "Appropriations Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Appropriations Ordinance describes, among other things, the existence of the Capital Improvements Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend said Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. O-18424, is hereby amended to continue the C.I.P. budget for the San Diego Convention Center Expansion Project, C.I.P. #37-010.0, in the amount of \$216,294,878.

Section 2. The City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$216,294,878 from San Diego Convention Center Expansion Project,


C.I.P. #37-010.0, with the intent that these expenses will be funded or reimbursed from future financing and other lawfully available sources.

Section 3. Upon certification by the City Manager that the costs are necessary and result from delays related to litigation, the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend, subject to the availability of appropriate funding sources, an additional amount not to exceed the equivalent of \$750,000 per month for each month of delay from February 1, 1998 until Golden Turner is authorized to proceed with initial actual construction activities.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
