RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE MARKET STREET (12TH AVENUE TO 26TH STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

whereas, by Resolution No. R-209320, a public hearing was called for
on December 9, 1997 at the hour of in the Council Chambers
of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether
the public health, safety, or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and
associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric
communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain
area of the City of San Diego, including the described public rights-of-way, more particularly
shown in the Legal Description attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein and as more
particularly shown on Drawing No. 27527-D, entitled "MARKET STREET (12TH AVENUE
TO 26TH STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in
the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR289528

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the public health, safety, and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date on which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations, and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution)

and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Lots 4 - 9 of BLOCK 1 of SHERMAN'S ADDITION TO SAN DIEGO MAP 856;

Portion LOTS 1 - 5 of BLOCK 16 of PLAT of CULVERWELL'S ADDITION to SAN DIEGO MAP 143;

Lot 4 of BLOCK 18, Lots 4 - 9 of BLOCK 2 of PLAN of SHERMAN'S ADDITION to SAN DIEGO MAP 856;

Lots 2 - 7 of BLOCK 17 of PLAT of CULVERWELL'S ADDITION to SAN DIEGO MAP 143;

13TH STREET between the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 250 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

14TH STREET between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 250 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

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15TH STREET between a line parallel to and 80 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 250 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

16TH STREET between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 250 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>17TH STREET</u> between the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 96 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

19TH STREET between the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 50 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>20TH STREET</u> between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>21ST STREET</u> between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>22ND STREET</u> between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>24TH STREET</u> between a line parallel to and 35 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and northerly line of MARKET STREET;

<u>25TH STREET</u> between a line parallel to and 50 feet south of the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 25 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;

ALLEY BLOCK 23 between the southerly line of MARKET STREET and a line parallel to and 25 feet north of the northerly line of MARKET STREET;
