BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby congratulate and thank the Holiday Bowl Board of Directors, Holiday Bowl Committee, volunteers and ticket holders for 20 years of outstanding service to the community.

"more than a football game," and hereby proclaims Tuesday, March 17, 1998 to be "**HOLIDAY
