BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it restates its support for creating a world class Central Library by committing to put the project on the November 1998 ballot, or by Special Election in 1999.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council that it does not want conflicts in the approval of budgets for other CIP projects or the branch library measure at the same time the Central Library is on the ballot.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that as part of the City Council's budget deliberations, that the City Manager is directed to return to the City Council prior to June 1998 with a revised financing plan for the Central Library which addresses Council concerns regarding the capital costs of the project, its future operating costs, and looking at funding sources other than the Transit Occupancy Tax [TOT] now earmarked for the Central Library.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council that it hereby voices its concern that the above-mentioned TOT funds are being diverted from their original purpose which was for a Downtown Sports Entertainment Project, and to that end, directs the City Manager to look at

funding sources that could be used in lieu of the TOT funds currently allocated for the Central Library.
