WHEREAS, on June 30, 1997, the Council of The City of San Diego allocated \$145,000 in TransNet funding for the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund (30304); and

WHEREAS, Council District Five has directed the City Manager to transfer \$145,000 from the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund (30304) into the Fiscal Year 1998 Capital Improvements Program (CIP) for the upgrade/installation of three traffic signals in Mira Mesa; and

WHEREAS, Council District Five has directed that \$50,000 of the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund be transferred to CIP 68-011.0, Annual Allocation - Modernize Traffic Signals, to construct dual left turn lanes, westbound and eastbound from Mira Mesa Boulevard to Pacific Heights Boulevard and perform corresponding traffic signal improvements; and

WHEREAS, Council District Five has directed that \$5,000 of the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund be transferred to CIP 61-102.3, FY96 - Electrical Main, to create a northbound triple left turn lane from Scranton Road to Mira Mesa Boulevard and perform corresponding traffic signal improvements; and

WHEREAS, Council District Five has directed that \$90,000 of the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund be transferred to CIP 68-010.0, Annual Allocation - Construct Traffic Signals, to construct a traffic signal at the intersection of Pacific Heights Boulevard and Cornerstone Court, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that in accordance with the 1998 Appropriation Ordinance, the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to amend the Fiscal Year 1998 CIP budget by adding \$145,000 from the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/Economic Need Fund (30304).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$145,000 from the Mira Mesa Livable Neighborhood/ Economic Need Fund (30304), as follows:

\$50,000 to CIP 68-011.0, Annual Allocation - Modernize Traffic Signals \$5,000 to CIP 61-102.3, FY 96 - Electrical Main \$90,000 to CIP 68-010.0, Annual Allocation - Construct Traffic Signals

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$145,000 is hereby authorized, as follows:

An amount not to exceed \$50,000 from CIP 68-011.0, Annual Allocation - Modernize Traffic Signals, for improvements at the intersection of Mira Mesa Boulevard and Pacific Heights Boulevard.

An amount not to exceed \$5,000 from CIP 61-102.3, FY 96 - Electrical Main, for improvements at the intersection of Mira Mesa Boulevard and Scranton Road.

An amount not to exceed \$90,000 from CIP 68-010.0, Annual Allocation - Construct Traffic Signals, for improvements at the intersection of Pacific Heights Boulevard and Cornerstone Court.
