RESOLUTION NUMBER R-_____

ADOPTED ON APR 2 0 1998

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for demolition of the old Pump Station 65 and removal of the utility berm in Los Penasquitos Lagoon Preserve, on file in the office of the City Clerk on APR 2 0 1998, and bearing official Document No. W.O. 170511, be and the same are hereby approved.

2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the above work, in accordance with the plans and specifications referred to above.

3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the project, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury.


4. That the expenditure of a total amount not to exceed \$700,000 is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively as follows, and provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury:

\$481,875 from CIP 46-117.0, Pump Station 65 Expansion and Force Main, for construction and project related costs;

\$ 18,125 from CIP 46-193.0, Annual Allocation - Muni Sewer Pooled Contingency, for project contingency; and

\$200,000 from CIP 46-117.0, Pump Station 65 Expansion
and Force Main, for additional contingency and related costs
associated with the Valley Crest Landscape contract.
