WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department desires to apply for and if selected to accept and expend a grant from the California Youth Authority, for a program to provide early gang intervention and diversion services to youth ages 8-14 at Memoria Academy (middle school), and Sherman, King, Perkins and Logan Elementaries; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police on behalf of the City Manager, be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, expend and administer funds for the above named grant application, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-28953

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant acceptance, operation, contracts, expenditures, and certification that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City Manager, to accept, expend and administer any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding of this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the State of California;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to provide matching resources required and committed for said project (including any amendments thereof) under the program and funding terms and conditions of the State of California, and that this match will be appropriated as required;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance of this grant award agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the City of San Diego. The State of California and the California Youth Authority disclaim responsibility for any such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded hereunder are not subject to local hiring freezes.
