WHEREAS, the Natural Resources and Culture Committee requested the Water Department to review the merits of a program in San Diego to identify water and wastewater revenue losses attributable to billing and metering discrepancies and unmetered water use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also requested that the Water Department review the experience of other municipalities in recovering lost water use revenues and whether such a program, if viable, should be conducted by City Forces or through a contract; and

WHEREAS, the Water Department has determined that identifying water and wastewater revenue losses attributed to billing and metering discrepancies and unmetered water use is of benefit to the Department and the rate payer; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to implement an unbilled water use recovery program, by issuing a Request for Proposal for a consultant who specializes in this type of service.
