

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 289979

ADOPTED ON APR 20 1998

WHEREAS, in 1918, four Jewish women's clubs joined to form the Jewish Family Service of San Diego, an all volunteer social service agency aimed at "reconstructing individuals and families rather than encouraging pauperism;" and

WHEREAS, since 1918, the Jewish Family Service of San Diego and its many volunteers and supporters have worked diligently to provide a wide array of family oriented services and through those services have served the needs of tens of thousands of local residents; and

WHEREAS, through their Senior Service Program, every year the Jewish Family Service provides lunches, activities and social events for hundreds of local seniors, allowing seniors to live longer, healthier and more independent lives; and

WHEREAS, Jewish Family Services also focuses on the needs of children and through CHAMP, their child abuse prevention program, have provided 74,000 children, parents and educators with child abuse prevention training; and

WHEREAS, the newly inaugurated Jewish Big Brothers Program provides youth-at-risk with positive role models and life affirming activities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, this Council hereby recognizes the remarkable accomplishments and continued contributions of the Jewish Family Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Sunday, April 26, 1998, is hereby proclaimed to be
"JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE DAY" in the City of San Diego.
