## **Mitigated Negative Declaration**

SUBJECT:

North Torrey Pines Golf Course. COUNCIL APPROVAL of Capital Improvement Project No. 29-704 for the replacement of the existing irrigation system for the North Course of the Torrey Pines Golf Course with a new reclaimed water irrigation system consisting of approximately 48,500 linear feet of one to fourteen-inch diameter pipes and associated electrical lines. In addition, the project will replace approximately 3,400 feet of existing car paths and construct in approximately 10,200 feet of new cart paths varying from eight to ten feet in width. The 134-acre developed project site is located at 11480 North Torrey Pines Road, between Callan Road and Torrey Pines Park Road, in the Torrey Pines Mesa subarea of the University community (Portions of Lots 1331 and 1333, Map 36). Applicant: City of San Diego Parks and Recreation Department.

- I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: See attached Initial Study.
- II. ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING: See attached Initial Study.
- III. DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an Initial Study which determined that the proposed project could have a significant environmental effect in the following area: Cultural resources. Subsequent revisions in the project proposal create the specific mitigation identified in Section V of this Mitigated Negative Declaration. The project as revised now avoids or mitigates the potentially significant environmental effects previously identified, and the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report will not be required.

IV. DOCUMENTATION:

The attached Initial Study documents the reasons to support the above Determination.

V. MITIGATION, MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM:

As conditions of Council Approval for the North Torrey Pines Golf Course, the following measures are required to reduce potential adverse project impacts to cultural resources to below a level of significance.

## **CULTURAL RESOURCES**

1. Prior to any grading and/or excavation, the applicant shall provide verification that a qualified archaeologist and/or archaeological monitor has been retained to implement the archaeological construction monitoring program. This verification shall be in the form of a letter from the applicant to the Environmental Review Manager of the Land Development Review Division. ALL PERSONS INVOLVED IN THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL CONSTRUCTION MONITORING OF THIS PROJECT SHALL BE APPROVED BY LDR PRIOR TO THE START OF MONITORING.

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
