

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 290068

ADOPTED ON MAY 11 1998

APPROVING MAP OF THE VILLAGE IN LA JOLLA.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds that certain map surveyed by Michael D. Levine, Licensed Land Surveyor, titled "The Village in La Jolla" (the "MAP"), being a subdivision of a portion of Pueblo Lot 1261 of the Pueblo lands of San Diego according to map thereof made in 1870, and Lot 8 of Lone Pine Map No. 2819 recorded October 22, 1951, in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, in The City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, is made in the manner and form prescribed by law and conforms to the surrounding surveys; that the MAP is in substantial conformance with the Tentative Map No. 96-0581; that the MAP and the subdivision of land shown thereon is approved and accepted.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council accepts on behalf of The City of San Diego, the easements with the right of ingress and egress for the construction and maintenance of sewer facilities, designated as "Sewer Easement Granted Hereon", as granted and shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions set forth on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council accepts on behalf of The City of San Diego, the access easement in Lots 1 through 6 inclusive with the right of ingress and egress for the maintenance of the public sewer facilities, designated as "Access Easement Granted Hereon", as granted and shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions set forth on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is authorized and directed to endorse upon the MAP, as and for the act of the Council, that the Council has approved the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to transmit the MAP to the County Recorder of the County of San Diego, California, for recordation.
