

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 230080

ADOPTED ON MAY 11 1998

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department desires to apply for, accept and expend a grant from the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning for a program called the "Coordinated Agency Network," the purpose of which is to provide supervision and guidance to low-risk probationary youth in the communities of Otay Mesa and San Ysidro; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is the applicant and grantee; and the program will be operated jointly with the San Diego County Office of Probation, in partnership with numerous community agencies; all required agreements will be processed separately and are not a part of this resolution and will include a contractual evaluation of the program by an independent agency; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City Manager, be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, expend and administer funds for the above named grant application, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 230080.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant acceptance, operation, contracts, expenditures, and certifications that the City will comply with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City Manager, to accept, expend and administer any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding of this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is

made available by the State of California and/or the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City agrees to provide matching resources required or committed for said project (including any amendments thereof) under the Program and funding terms and conditions of the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning, and that this match will be appropriated as required;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the City of San Diego. The State of California and the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning disclaim responsibility for any such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded hereunder are not subject to local hiring freezes.
