

RESOLUTION NO. 290085

ADOPTED ON MAY 11 1998

WHEREAS, The San Diego Zoological Society entered into an Operating Agreement with the City of San Diego on March 3, 1969 to establish, maintain, and operate a wild game preserve and associated uses on certain City-owned land (Wild Animal Park); and

WHEREAS, the Zoological Society provides important public services at the Wild Animal Park, including a variety of educational programs and opportunities; and


WHEREAS, the Zoological Society desires to expand these educational programs by developing a joint-use educational facility with the San Pasqual Union School District at the Wild Animal Park; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego hereby finds that the construction and maintenance of temporary classrooms and accessory structures at the Wild Animal Park by the San Pasqual Union School District for a joint-use educational facility is consistent with the intent of the Operating Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Consent to Joint-Use Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 290085 , which will allow the San Pasqual Union School District to construct temporary classrooms and accessory

structures pursuant to section 7 of the Operating Agreement.
