

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 290132

ADOPTED ON MAY 26 1998

WHEREAS, National Trails Day will be recognized on June 6, 1998; and

WHEREAS, National Trails Day is celebrated by over 3,000 trail organizations, agencies and businesses across the country who will host a variety of events including new trail dedications, workshops, educational exhibits, equestrian and mountain bike rides, hiking at a variety of locations from mountain ridges to shorelines; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Park and Recreation Department has joined with the San Diego Natural History Museum, Adventure 16, San Diego County Department of Parks and Recreation and the San Diego Parks Society in celebrating trails by sponsoring more than 90 trail hikes and maintenance projects from April 25-June 6, 1998; and

WHEREAS, this six-week effort, beginning with county-wide hikes, rides and trail projects on California Trails Day, April 25, 1998, and finishing with a grand finale in Balboa Park honoring National Trails Day on June 6, 1998, will celebrate trails in San Diego and support the "Spines to Pines" Trans-County Trail, a 114 mile trail from Anza-Borrego Desert State Park to Torrey Pines State Reserve; and

WHEREAS, National Trails Day will call attention to the diverse benefits of trails and increase public awareness of the importance of protecting these resources; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby recognize National Trails Day, and further recognizes The City of San Diego Park and Recreation Department, the San Diego Natural

History Museum, Adventure 16, San Diego County Department of Parks and Recreation, the San Diego County Parks Society, and numerous volunteers of The City of San Diego Park and Recreation Department, Park Rangers and volunteers for their for organizing a county-wide celebration of trails.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that June 6, 1998 is hereby proclaimed to be "**National Trails Day**" in The City of San Diego.
