RESOLUTION NUMBER R-290255

ADOPTED ON JUNE 15, 1998

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public service easements by City Council resolution where the easement is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the Biona Drive storm drain replacement is required in conjunction with the new storm drain being placed in Adams Avenue which will replace the existing six-foot storm drain easement currently running beneath the residences at 4711-4721 Biona Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the drainage easement for public street purposes; and
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
- (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the drainage system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the drainage easement in Lots 1 and 2, Block B, and Lots 2-5 Block A, Kensington Park Annex, Map No. 1780, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18522-B attached hereto and made a part hereof, be and the same is ordered vacated.
 - 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Quitclaim Deed conveying all

the City's right, title and interest in an unneeded drainage easement over a portion of Lot 1, Block B, Kensington Park Annex, Map 1780, to Jack W. Page, as sole owner, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-290255-1.

- 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Quitclaim Deed conveying all the City's right, title and interest in an unneeded drainage easement in a portion of Lot 2, Block A, Kensington Park Annex, Map 1780, to Elvira Fernandez, as Trustee, or her successors, in Trust, U/D/T, dated January 12, 1995, F/B/O the Elvira Fernandez Living Trust, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-290255-2.
- 4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Quitclaim Deed conveying all the City's right, title and interest in an unneeded drainage easement over a portion of Lots 3, 4 and 5, Block A, Kensington Park Annex, Map 1780, to Beverly Jean Logan as to an undivided one-half interest and William Davis, Sr. as to an undivided one-half interest, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-290255-3.
- 5. That the acceptance by the City Manager of an easement deed of Jack W. Page, as sole owner, executed in favor of The City of San Diego, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-290255-4, granting to said City the Northerly 10 feet of the Westerly 75 feet of Lot 1, Block B of Kensington Park Annex, Map 1780, as more particularly described in the deed, is approved.
- 6. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,500 for property acquisition and related costs from the Biona Storm Drain

Replacement Fund 30244, Org. 101, Object Account 4638, C.I.P. 17-001.0.


