

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 290437

ADOPTED ON JUL 20 1998

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public service easements by City Council resolution where the easement has been superseded by relocation and there are no other public facilities located within the easement; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of the drainage easement and the general utility and access easement in portions of Lots 1 and 2 of Stonecrest Village Unit No. 2, Map No. 13508, to unencumber this property and facilitate development of the site; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

(a) there is no present or prospective use for the drainage easement and the general utility and access easement either for the public service system, for which the easements were originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated; and

(b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

(c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and

(d) the public service systems for which the easements were originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


1. That the drainage easement in a portion of Lot 1 of Stonecrest Village Unit No. 2, Map

No. 13508, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18776-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 290437-1, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

2. That the general utility and access easement in a portion of Lot 2 of Stonecrest Village Unit No. 2, Map No. 13508, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18744-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 290437-2, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

3. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
