A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND SUBGRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress, under Public Law 89-665, has authorized the establishment of the National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid Program [Program] which provides matching funds to states and their eligible subdivisions, to promote historic preservation objectives, including surveys, registration of eligible structures, training, and education; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation for the State of California is responsible for the administration of the Program within California, and for setting up rules and procedures that govern the applications of the Program; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, as a Certified Local Government, is an eligible subdivision of the State of California, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to file an application and execute all necessary documents in connection therewith, for the National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid Program, for the following project to be administered on behalf of the City by the Community and Economic Development Department: This would be a \$25,000 project of which 60% (\$15,000) would come from the California Office of Historic Preservation and would facilitate Phase I of a Comprehensive Historic Preservation Plan for the San Diego Presidio

archeology site above Old Town. The City's 40% matching requirement (\$10,000) will be in the form of equivalent in-kind services of existing personnel for supervision and support.

2. The City Manager or duly authorized representative is further authorized to accept and expend funds if the grant is awarded in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the approved grant.
