WHEREAS, On June 10, 1998, Sea World of California filed with the City Clerk's Office an initiative petition regarding the Coastal Zone height restriction (People's Ordinance No. 10960 N.S.); and

WHEREAS, the petition was filed within the prescribed time period of 180 days following the date of publication of a notice of intent to circulate the petition; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1998, the Registrar of Voters completed the petition signature verification by use of a random sampling method authorized by the San Diego Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the petition was found to contain the valid signatures of over ten percent of the City's registered voters as required by the Charter for direct submission of the voters; and

WHEREAS, People's Ordinance No. 10960 N.S. was enacted by the voters as Proposition D on November 7, 1972, limiting the height of buildings in the Coastal Zone; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.2528 requires that any initiated legislative act adopted by a majority mote of the voters may be amended or repealed only by a vote of the majority of the voters or by Charter amendment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Council hereby directs the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance placing the initiative measure on the ballot at a municipal election consolidated with the next general statewide election on November 3, 1998.
