WHEREAS, Chapter 659, Statutes of 1997 (SB 368, Peace), included appropriations from the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account to the California Energy Commission for legislatively mandated projects; and

WHEREAS, SB 368 requires that such legislatively mandated projects be allocated by the California Energy Commission to the recipient; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego wants to use \$100,000 from the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account to purchase alternative fuel vehicles to provide transportation for children participating in the San Diego County Critical Hours program; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles will serve as an alternative to single occupancy and gasfueled vehicles and will provide an opportunity to educate and inform San Diego's youth and community leaders about alternative fuel vehicles and the importance of energy conservation; and

WHEREAS, due to drafting errors, the \$100,000 authorized for this purpose by SB 368 was mistakenly and incorrectly designated for The City of San Diego, rather than the County of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to subaward to the County of San Diego, \$100,000 of the

Petroleum Violation Escrow Account (PVEA) the City received from the California Energy Commission, to purchase alternative fuel vehicles for the San Diego County Critical Hours program.
