RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESCINDING THE 1984 MID-CITY COMMUNITY PLAN, ADOPTING THE MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLAN, AND AMENDING THE CITY'S PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN ACCORDINGLY.

WHEREAS, on June 18, 1998, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego [Planning Commission] held a public hearing for the purpose of considering an update to the Mid-City Community Plan, known as the "Mid-City Communities Plan," and associated amendments to the Progress Guide and General Plan, adoption of the Mid-City Public Facilities Financing Plan, adoption of a Development Impact Fee, amendment to the Mid-City Communities Planned District Ordinance, certification of Environmental Impact Report [EIR] LDR No. 98-8207, and adoption of the EIR Findings and Statement of Overriding Considerations; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2648-PC, the Planning Commission approved and recommended adoption by the Council of The City of San Diego [Council] of the Mid-City Communities Plan and associated actions; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 600-7 provides that public hearings to consider revisions to the Progress Guide and General Plan for The City of San Diego may be scheduled concurrently with public hearings on proposed community plans in order to retain consistency between said plans and the Planning Commission has held such concurrent public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered all maps, exhibits, and written documents contained in the file for this project on record in The City of San Diego, and has considered the oral presentations given at the public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it rescinds the 1984 Mid-City Community Plan and adopts the 1998 Mid-City Communities Plan, a copy of the Mid-City Communities Plan is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR-290608.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council adopts an amendment to the Progress Guide and General Plan for The City of San Diego to incorporate the above updated plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council finds that this plan update is consistent with the City adopted Regional Growth Management Strategy, and directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of this resolution to SANDAG in its capacity as the Regional Planning and Growth Management Review Board.
