WHEREAS, on June 18, 1998, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego held a public hearing for the purpose of considering the Grant Hill Revitalization Action Program; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2659-PC, the Planning Commission approved and recommended approval by the Council of The City of San Diego [Council] of the Grant Hill Revitalization Action Program; and


WHEREAS, the Grant Hill Revitalization Action Program is a feasibility and planning document describing general strategies for implementation of previous documents adopted by the City Council which include: the Southeast San Diego Community Plan (adopted July 13, 1987), the Grant Hill Historic District (adopted February 24, 1988), and the Historic District Design Criteria and Guidelines (adopted March 27, 1987); and

WHEREAS, this activity is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies); and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered all maps, exhibits, and written documents contained in the file for this project on record in the City of San Diego, and has considered the oral presentations given at the public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it hereby adopts the
Grant Hill Revitalization Action Program, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk
as Document No. RR- 290611.
