BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to add the aforesaid to the Council Policy Manual.

ATTACHMENT D

Proposed amended City Council Policy 400-9

Add an item to section E.(Numbered 8) which reads:

Support and encourage the use of reclaimed water by exempting manufacturing, processing, and research and development firms from mandatory potable water use restrictions ("cutbacks"), if all of the following conditions are met: 1) the business is one of the types of businesses described in categories 2000 through 3999, 7390, and 8730 of the Standard Industrial Classification Code; 2) the business is located in an area where reclaimed water is available; 3) the business uses reclaimed water on its premises to the full extent possible; and 4) the business participates in all applicable City water conservation programs which are considered Best Management Practices by the California Urban Water Conservation Council.
