RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED  
CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE  
OFFICES OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, by Resolution R-288127 adopted on December 2, 1996, the City Council approved the City Council's Conflict of Interest Code, which was revised and updated following the required City-wide biennial review of all conflict of interest codes for which the City Council serves as code reviewing body; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 87306 requires agencies to amend their conflict of interest codes whenever an amendment is necessitated by changed circumstances, including the creation of new positions which must be designated and relevant changes in the duties assigned to existing positions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has proposed changes to Appendix B of that office's conflict of interest code to accurately reflect appropriate disclosure categories; NOW,  
THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council's proposed changes to Appendix B of that office's conflict of interest code are hereby approved and are incorporated into its conflict of interest code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revised Appendix B to the City Council's Conflict of Interest Code be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revised Conflict of Interest Code for the Office of the City Council become effective upon the date of adoption of this resolution.

**APPENDIX B**

As used in Appendix B, "the City" means the City of San Diego.

Category 1: Investments and business positions in any business entity located in or doing business with the City.

Income and gifts from sources located in or doing business with the City.

Interests in real property located in the City, including property located within a two-mile radius of any property owned or used by the City.

Category 2: Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall (As required) disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Councilmember may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Councilmember's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.
