WHEREAS, on September 18, 1998, Captain Lee Vaughn retired from the San Diego Police Department after 24 years of dedicated service; and

WHEREAS, throughout his distinguished career, Captain Lee Vaughn was best known for the outstanding role he played as an informal leader, role model and motivator for many of his peers, and was often referred to as an "inspiration to others;" and

WHEREAS, among his many accomplishments, Captain Lee Vaughn was instrumental in developing and expanding the Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol and other volunteer programs at the San Diego Police Department's Northeastern Division, and as a direct result of his efforts to appoint a Community Volunteer Officer to develop a recruiting process for volunteers, The City of San Diego now has more than 452 volunteer patrol officers; and

WHEREAS, Captain Lee Vaughn, as an original member of the Board of Directors, was one of the guiding forces behind the development of the Police Foundation, a non-profit corporation created to accept donations to assist with law enforcement needs; NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby extend their best wishes and gratitude to Captain Lee Vaughn and acknowledge that his contagious, cheerful and positive attitude will be sorely missed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, this Council is honored to congratulate and thank Captain Lee Vaughn for his dedicated commitment to protecting and serving the residents of the City of San Diego for the past 24 years, and hereby proclaims Thursday, November 5, 1998 to be "**CAPTAIN LEE VAUGHN DAY**" in The City of San Diego.
