RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 290912

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public streets by City Council resolution where the portion of the street to be vacated is excess to the City's right-of-way needs and is no longer required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owner has requested the partial vacation of Olive Street in order to remedy a non-conforming condition; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Olive Street proposed for vacation contains a public service easement, specifically a sewer and water eassement, which will be reserved.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use that portion of the street proposed for vacation either for the public street system, for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the portion of the right-of-way proposed for vacation is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes; and
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
- (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) those properties adjoining that portion of the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and
 - (e) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be

detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That a portion of Olive Street, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18801-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-_______, which are attached

hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

2. That the vacation shall be conditioned upon and not become effective unless and until

the applicant shall obtain an Encroachment Removal Agreement for a carport and shed in a sewer

and water easement, satisfactory to the City Engineer. In the event that this is not accomplished

within one year following the adoption of this resolution, this resolution shall become void and

be of no further force or effect.

2. That upon notification from the City Engineer of the satisfactory recordation of the

Encroachment Removal Agreement, the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution,

with Exhibit "A", attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


