WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public streets by City Council resolution where the portion of the street to be vacated is excess to the City's right-of-way needs and is no longer required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owner has requested the partial vacation of Rushville Street to remedy a non-conforming condition; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for that portion of the street proposed for vacation either for the public street system, for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the portion of the right-of-way proposed for vacation is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes; and
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
- (c) the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) those properties adjoining that portion of the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and
- (e) the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That Rushville Street at the alley easterly of Draper Street, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 18835-B and Exhibit "A" on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 290913, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing and exhibit, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


