RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE SAN DIEGO CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act (California Government Code sections 81000-91015) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 87306.5 requires biennial review of local conflict of interest codes every even-numbered year; and

WHEREAS, as The City of San Diego's code reviewing body, the City Council finds it in the public interest to adopt the standard conflict of interest code promulgated by the FPPC in Regulation 18730 and hereby declares its intention to incorporate by reference the terms of FPPC Regulation 18730 and any amendments to that regulation duly adopted by the FPPC as part of each conflict of interest code for which the City Council has responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System has proposed changes to the Appendix A and Appendix B of its Conflict of Interest Code to clarify disclosure requirements and to better conform to the Government Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed changes to Appendix A, in which persons are designated, and Appendix B, in which disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby approved and are incorporated into the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System's Conflict of Interest Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Appendix A and Appendix B, as revised, be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 290926.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revised Conflict of Interest Code for the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System become effective upon the date of adoption of this resolution.

DISCLOSURE CATEGORY

Category 1: Investments and business positions in any business entity that supplies goods or services to the Retirement System, and in any security which was or is held by any fund administered by Board of Administration wherein the reporting party's interest in said security amounts to one percent (1%) or more of the issue of that security.

Income and gifts from any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the Retirement System.

Interests in real property.

For purposes of this Appendix, "goods or services" means goods or services supplied by any actuarial, accounting, banking, financial, investment or consulting firm.

For purposes of this Appendix, an interest in real property is any property located in or within two miles of the City of San Diego or within two miles of any land owned by the Retirement System as set forth in the Attachment to this Appendix which lists the real properties owned by the Retirement System in its Direct and Co-investment Real Estate Portfolio. A copy of this attachment is also on file in the Retirement Office.
