


RESOLUTION NUMBER R-291250

ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 1, 1999

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to recommend to the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the International Boundary and Water Commission that the Bajagua Project be included as one of the options for treating Tijuana sewage to be evaluated in the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for the International Boundary and Water Commission, South Bay International Wastewater Treatment Plant, Long Term Treatment Options, as set forth in City Manager Report's No. 99-02, on file in the office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to recommend that secondary treatment be achieved using a conventional activated sludge treatment process if the Bajagua Project is not found to be feasible.
