Community Planners Committee, where she represented the committee before the City Council and the City Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hooper has served and presently serves on several advisory councils, boards, and commissions in the City and County of San Diego, including the San Diego County Assessment Appeals Board # 1, the City of San Diego Transportation Advisory Board and the Areawide Committee on Transit, Metropolitan Transit Development Board; and

WHEREAS, she was a member of the San Diego County Grand Jury and the Executive Board for the Association of Retired Grand Jurors; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend Ms. Jewell Hooper for her years of commitment and devotion, not only to the Council District but to the community as a whole.
