RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 291325

ADOPTED ON MAR 22 1999

WHEREAS, the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP) has issued a Request for Proposals for Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grants, from funds made available to states by the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, OCJP has allocated the funds to units of local government based on a formula of law enforcement expenditures and violent crime arrest data, making the allocation to the City of San Diego \$414,650; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego has proposed, and the City of San Diego concurs with, a plan to merge the block grant funds allocated to the City and County of San Diego, for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a collaborative interagency information sharing program for the mutual benefit of both jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, OCJP has approved this collaborative plan, pending receipt of Council resolution authorizing such collaboration; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that The City of San Diego waives its claim to receive, or to directly engage in any project requiring the use of, its allocation of these funds, on condition that the County of San Diego applies for, accepts, and expends these funds for a collaborative interagency information sharing program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego hereby authorizes the County of San Diego to apply for, accept and expend the City's full entitlement of these funds in the amount of \$414, 650;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authorization includes all aspects of grant and program application, acceptance, operation, contracts, expenditures, and certification of compliance with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of San Diego has agreed to provide all required matching funds, including the portion of matching funds for the City's allocation, under the funding terms and conditions of this program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and that City personnel positions funded hereunder, if any, are not subject to local hiring freezes;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement and program, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the sole

responsibility of the grant recipient and not of the City of San Diego or the State of California.

The City, State and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.
