BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager is hereby directed to restore \$225,276 of the 3/4 of one percent cut in the Fiscal Year 1999 Fire and Life Safety Services Department programs as part of the Fiscal Year 1999 Year-End Budget Adjustments.
- 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to reaffirm the following budget priorities:
  (a) Public Safety and Health; (b) Neighborhood Pride and Protection; and (c) Economic Development.
- 3. That the City Manager is hereby directed to include as part of the Fire and Life Safety Services Department Fiscal Year 2000 Budget, \$675,823 for minimum base restoration of the 3/4 of one percent cut, with a priority on funding apparatus/equipment maintenance and repair.
- 4. That the City Manager is hereby directed to work with the Fire Chief on the overtime issue.
- 5. That the City Manager is hereby directed to return all profits of the EMS system back to the EMS system enhancements, and to restore the Coastal Infrastructure Fund at a minimum funding level of \$1.5 million/year, from Transient Occupancy Tax for Fiscal Year 2000.
